

# BARK CITY DOGGY DAYCARE

## Hotel Rules and Requirements

### **New Customers**

All new customers are required to bring their dog in for a trial day prior to boarding. This enables us to determine which of our programs would be a better fit for your dog. If you are unable to bring your dog in for a trial day we will require the first time it boards with us that it is scheduled in our Luxury boarding. This way we can evaluate your dog with a few number of dogs to determine whether it would be accepted into our standard boarding facility.

### **Food**

We highly recommend you bring your own food for your dog to avoid changes in the dog's diet. If you do NOT bring food for your dog you will be charged \$2 per meal for our house food (anything over 2cups/meal will be additional \$1/cup)

### **Medication**

Make sure medication is labeled and dosage instructions are included.

### **Flea and Tick Prevention**

All dogs must be on a flea and tick prevention program. This can be an all natural topical treatment. NO FLEA COLLARS. We are asked all the time why we require this and it is simply a safety precaution for your dog. Bozeman is becoming more and more popular with people moving for all over the world and visiting from all over. We do get out of state dogs all year round. This helps us insure that we are keeping everyone safe while they are in our care.

### **Emergency**

In case you dog becomes ill while in our care please make sure you have provided us with not only contact information for you but also for an emergency contact. We will always try to contact you, your emergency contact and your local vet immediately.

In case of an emergency during business hours we will try to get your dog to its regular vet or the vet nearest to us. If it is during afterhours/weekends we will be taking your dog to the PET Emergency clinic.

### **Belongings**

Bark City does provide blankets (upgrade to additional bedding for a small fee. Please see our amenities page), water and food bowls. Please do not bring any bedding that cannot be washed in a standard washing machine. Only beds with covers that can come off will be allowed in the Hotel. Please note that sometimes dogs will chew on bedding that they normally wouldn't while boarding. Bark City is not responsible for any lost or damaged belongings. We will not put toys/treats in a kennel that could be a choking hazard. Please bring no more than 3 toys per dog.

### **Health**

Hotel stays require a veterinarian certificate indicating proof of vaccinations for Rabies, Distemper, Bordetella, at least 7 days prior to stay. Titer protection may be substituted for certain vaccinations, but must have written proof from your vet. Puppies under 4 months old must be current on the vaccinations they can be plus have a Bordetella and a health check from a vet prior to boarding.

### **Allergies**

Please inform us at time of check in or registration if your dog has any allergies.

**Separation Anxiety**

If your dog has separation anxiety we strongly urge you to use the services of a pet-sitter or house sitter. Boarding a dog with separation anxiety is not safe or kind to your dog. It is also stressful to other dogs being boarded, and you may end up with extreme costs to replace/repair the physical damage that your dog does to the boarding facility. Your dog could also seriously injure themselves in attempts to escape the boarding facility. If your dog has separation anxiety and you want to board with us it **MUST COMPLETE AN EVALUATION PRIOR TO BOARDING**. We may also require it comes here for multiple daycare days before it is allowed to board. We have the right to refuse the dog if we still feel it could be potentially harmful for your pet.
